They test their skills in the art of Casting, Flipping, and Pitching a plastic jig to a very colorful target.

The goal of the WBF is to expose our youth from the ages of 8 to 15 to the great sport of fishing. More than 50 youngsters were assisted Saturday morning by Rockford Hawg Hunter’s members.
